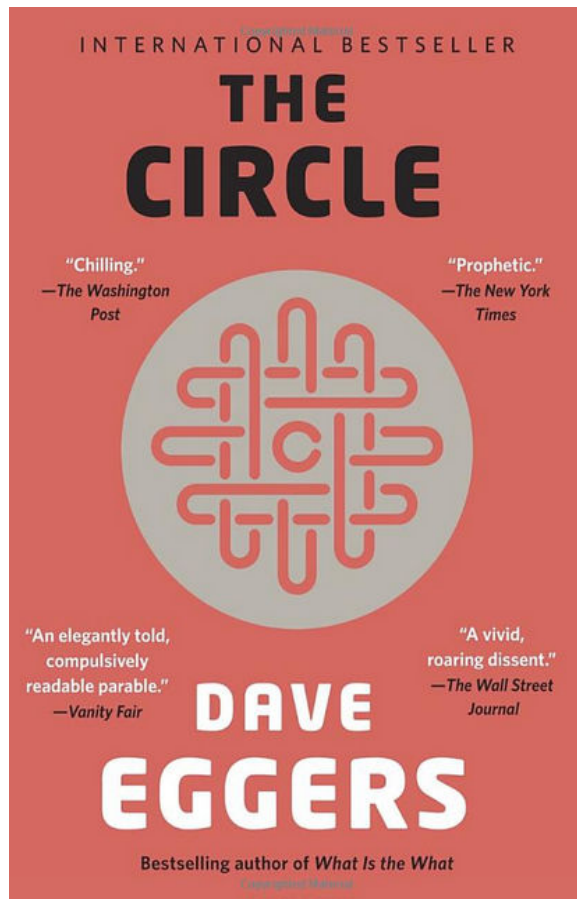


# The Circle
