FSCPL-- bad news is that we lost two members. They are recruiting for two new members. The Friends raised \$15,000 through Santa Cruz Gives for their Recover and Thrive program this summer. The fundraising has been going really well. And the new Advocacy Committee is doing great outreach in both Spanish and English.

President's Report: Measure O was defeated so the Downtown Library is going forward. We voted on a new variation on our new logo-- that was approved. We are organizing a treat basket for the downtown library workers-- please plan to donate a treat of some sort and deliver it to Debby's house. Let's start getting together for lunch again in February. We are continuing to do the Farmers Market-- please volunteer for a shift. We agreed to zoom the January and February meetings again. Book sale on March 25th-- set up on the 24th. And dinner to follow. Please put it on your calendar to help. WE NEED BOOKS. Lynn will help Gale with the Opening Day celebration.
